Our World - Geography & History



The world 22 to 36 months:

Notices detailed features of objects in their environment.

The world 30 to 50 months:

- Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.
- Can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects.
- Talks about why things happen and how things work.
- Developing an understanding of growth, decay and changes over time.
- Shows care and concern for living things and the environment.

The World 40 to 60 months:

- Looks closely at similarities, differences, patterns & change.

Early Learning Goal:

- Children know about similarities & differences in relation to places, objects, materials & living things. They talk about the features of their own immediate environment & how environments might vary from one another. They make observations of animals & plants & explain why some things occur & talk about changes.

People and communities 22 to 36 months:

- Has a sense of own immediate family and relations.

People and communities 30 to 50 months:

- Shows interest in the lives of people who are familiar to them.
- Remembers and talks about significant events in their own experience.

People and communities 40 to 60 months:

- Enjoys joining in with family customs & routines.

ELG:

Children talk about past & present events in their own lives
in the lives of family members. They know that other
children don't always enjoy the same things, & are sensitive to this. They know about
similarities & differences between themselves & others, & among families,
communities & traditions.
