## Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring \& Using Media and Materials
22 to 36 months:

- Experiments with blocks, colours and marks.

30 to 50 months:

- Joins construction pieces together to build and balance.
- Realises tools can be used for a purpose.

40 to 60 months:

- Experiments to create different textures.
- Understands that different media can be combined to create new effects.
- Manipulates materials to achieve a planned effect.
- Uses simple tools and techniques competently \& appropriately.
- Selects appropriate resources \& adapts work where necessary.
- Selects tools \& techniques needed to shape, assemble \& join materials they are using.
ELG:
- They safely use \& explore a variety ofmaterials, tools \& techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form \& function.


## Being Imaginative

22 to 36 months:

- Beginning to use representation to communicate, e.g. drawing a line and saying 'That's me.'
30 to 50 months:
- Captures experiences and responses with a range of materials.

40 to 60 months:

- Chooses particular colours to use for a purpose.

ELG:

- They represent their own ideas in design \& technology.


## Physical Development

Moving and Handling
22 to 36 months:

- Shows control in holding and using jugs to pour, hammers, books and mark-making tools.
- Beginning to use three fingers (tripod grip) to hold writing tools
- Imitates drawing simple shapes such as circles and lines.

30 to 50 months:

- Uses one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. makes snips in paper with child scissors.

40 to 60 months:
Uses tools to effect changes to materials.

- Handles tools, objects, construction \& malleable materials safely \& with increasing control.
ELG:
- They handle equipment \& tools effectively.
