We will be learning the names of different bugs, going on a bug hunt around the school grounds and to conclude, there will be an ugly bug ball where you will get to dress up as your favourite bug. We will also be learning about ourselves and our bodies. After half term, Reception will be reading the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs' and will be meeting the characters from the book in Story World. The Three Pigs need your help! We also have a visit from the local Fire Brigade to talk to you about keeping yourself safe on bonfire night. We finish the term performing a Nativity production 'Donkey for Sale' and your parents and grandparents come to watch how fantastic you are! We also have a Christmas school trip to Norton Priory.

Spring Term is jam pack too with lots of exciting things. We are back to Story World to meet another character called Max from a book called 'Where the Wild Things Are'. Max likes to be mischievous, so watch out in case he tries to get you to be mischievous as well. We will also be learning about animals and where they live and we will be learning about materials and how to describe them. Story World continues with another new book 'What the Ladybird Heard'. This time, you get to meet a very quiet Ladybird who is trying to stop two robbers stealing the 'Prize Cow'. We have to set up a Police Station, so we can catch the robbers and make lots of wanted posters. Once the robbers are caught and put in prison, our adventure can continue.

We meet more characters in Story World; a little boy called Jack who needs help because his Gran has mysterious purple spots and a Superhero who we have to rescue as he has been kidnapped. At Easter, we will be flipping pancakes and searching for Easter eggs around the school grounds which have been left by the Easter Bunny. We will also be learning about how to look after plants and will be looking at how environments are different. We finish the year by visiting your new classroom and getting to know your new teacher and you will also be going on a surprise special trip!
