Respect

- The class that all listened and responded quickly when the teacher asked for quiet
- A Teaching Assistant who modified her instructions when a child was struggling to understand

- The group of children who helped a child when they fell over outside

Honesty

- The child who shared with Family Support Worker about his low self esteem
- The child who wrote a prayer asking God to help him listen more carefully
