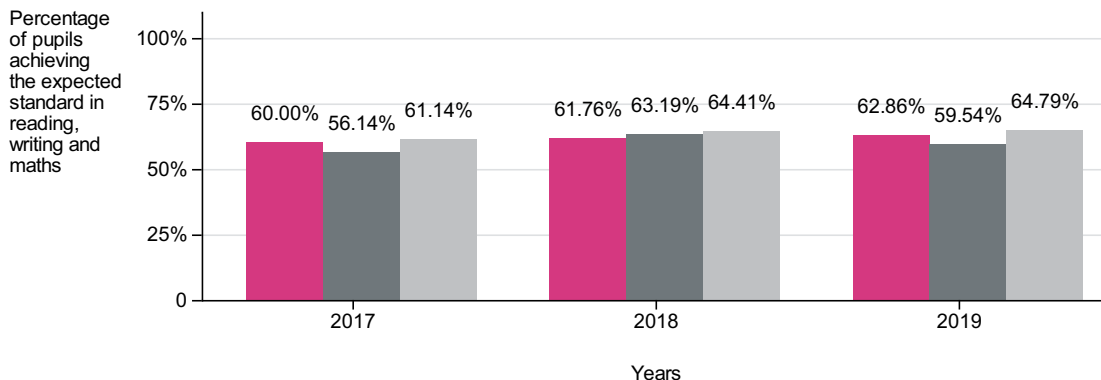
## Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard or higher

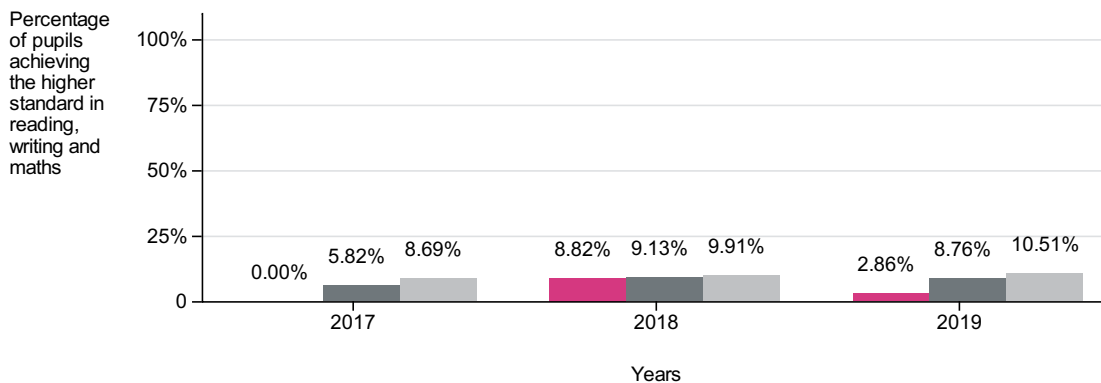
## Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

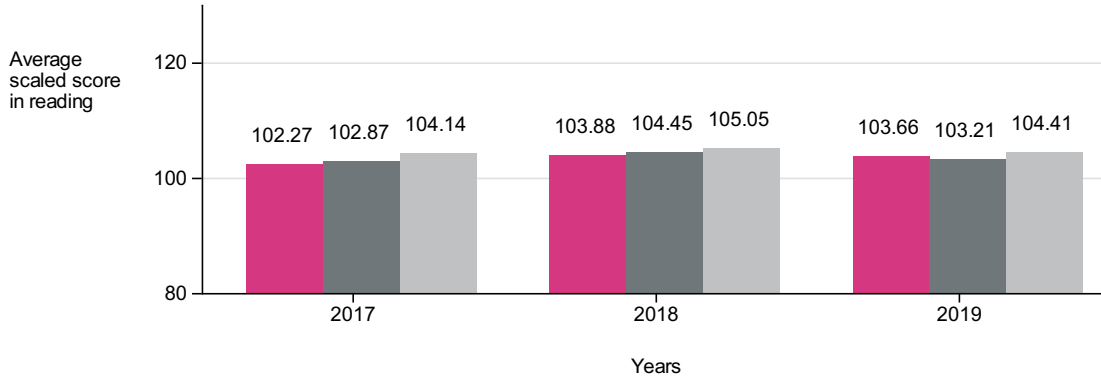
