

## Remote Learning 2021

Dear Parents,

Remote learning at St Mary's will begin tomorrow (6.1.21) and will consist of tasks and activities set on Microsoft Teams by your child's teacher. Live/interactive lessons will start on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January. The lessons will be scheduled by the class teachers and support staff and will begin at the following times:

Year 5 and 6: 8:45am – 9:15am

Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4: 9:15am – 9:45am

Reception and Year 1: 9:45am – 10:10am

Nursery 10 am Monday – Wednesday

During these sessions, the staff will explain the tasks for the day. The staff will then be available throughout the day to answer questions and call children who need help. Children will be told how to submit work and then given feedback. There will then be another face to face lesson in the afternoon to review the days learning and an end of day activity/story.

The timetable is as follows:

8:45-9:15 Y5 and Y6

9:15 – 9:45 Y2, Y3 and Y4

9:45-10:10 Reception and Y1

2:15pm-2:45pm Y5 and Y6

2:45pm-3:15pm Y2, Y3 and Y4

3:15pm-3:40pm Reception and Y1

In addition to staff delivering these online sessions, they will also be responsible for teaching in school on a rota. This will mean that each year group will have a day a week when tasks will be set, but there will be no online interaction with their teacher as their teacher will be teaching key worker children in school. Class teachers will let their pupils know when this will be the case.

This is a new venture for us all, and we know there will be teething problems, Please do not panic – we will get through this together.
