Pupil Monitoring for Science Years 3 & 4

Do you know the term 'scientific enquiry' and what do you think it means? Most children did not know the term Action – Teach the term 'scientific enquiry'

Yes. E.g. 100g of flour- we could show that in a bar.

Counting in 2's and 3's is quicker to count.

Adults and teachers.

How do you know if you have done well in science?

Book will be marked with a good comment. Teachers may give us extra challenging questions.

What new words have you learnt in science?

Skull. Repel. Attract, joint, diary, protein, fibre, carbohydrate, marble.

Is there anything else you would like to tell me about your learning in science?
