PSHE/RSE learning Opportunity Examples

- Daily conversations about how our actions and behaviour have an impact on others feelings
- Daily conversations about waiting to take turns and sharing resources
- Activities that involve following instructions involving several ideas and actions
- Trying teacher led and child led activities that show independence, resilience and perseverance in the face of a challenge
- Explanations of our school rules and how we behave in school at different points in the school day
- Daily discussions on how to work and play co- operatively throughout the school day.
- Daily discussions on how to form positive relationships with adults, friends and peers
- Daily discussions on how to be sensitive to their own and to others' needs
- Assemblies
- Heartsmart lessons

PSHE/RSE provision:

- Books and pictures that show people in different situations and having different feelings
- All areas of provision within the EYFS classroom develop personal, social and emotional skills and knowledge through interaction with other children and adults within the classroom
