Children were asked what they thought about Collective Worship. They were also given freedom to make any suggestions as to how our worship could be improved, changed or adapted.

#### **Findings**

All pupils were very complimentary about Collective Worship sessions. Comments ranged from pupils who found sessions relaxing and enjoyable to some who really loved listening to stories and singing.

Children said they particularly enjoyed learning about the values which have been adopted by our whole school community. One child commented that these values help her at home. They love family assemblies and Bible stories. Children also love it when teachers share their own week. They enjoy celebrating birthdays or just sharing their own family news. Getting prizes and certificates also rated highly on what children particularly like.

Children feel they benefit from Collective Worship sessions as they learn about the Bible.

Children were asked whether there were any sessions they did not like. Every child said there was not!

When asked for improvements, many said they could not think of anything. One child however in key stage 2 said they did not like having to sit on the floor!
