

Music learning Opportunity Examples

- Singing in assembly
- Singing in collective worship
- Singing songs linked to other areas of learning
- Learning songs for Christmas performances and class assembly
- Singing well known nursery rhythms and songs
- Performing songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others and moving in time to the music
- Listening to lots of different types of music
- Using the instruments to make music when following the charanga music scheme
- Listening to music using the Charanga scheme, when going in and out of assembly, musical performances by other classes, visiting musicians and our arts celebration assemblies
- Singing solo's and as a group during sharing time
- Expressing how music makes them feel
- When learning new songs, matching the pitch of the songs
- Performing solo, as a class or as a school group in assembly or celebration days

Music provision:

- Box of musical instruments
- Rhymes and poems books
- Music boards outside
- Stage area outside for singing songs
- Pretend microphones to use in stage area for singing
