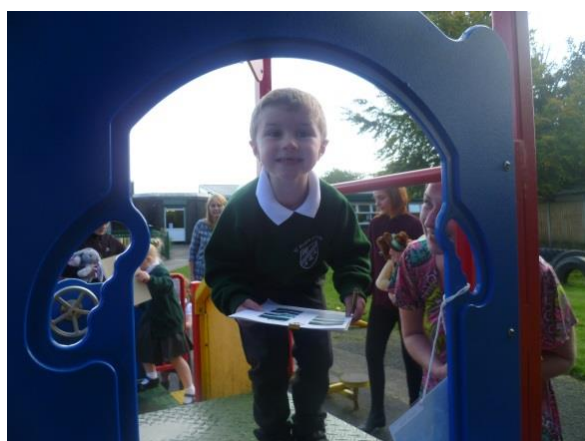


International Learning – Reception Class

France

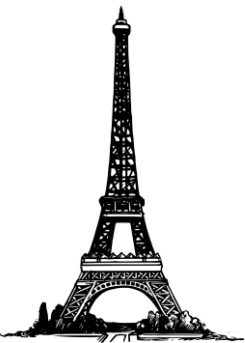


Year 3 have been busy making T-Shirts inspired by Coco Chanel and hats from newspaper.
